The National Black Prosecutors Association (NBPA) was founded in 1983 for the purposes of promoting the hiring, retention and training of African Americans in the field of criminal prosecution. Over the last three decades, our membership has grown to include chief elected prosecutors, line prosecutors, judges and law enforcement.
